The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. The Antelope Valley Public Landfill (AVPL) operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the LEA. On December 19, 2025, the LEA received a permit revision application package for the same project the City of Palmdale approved via CUP 98-12 Modification No.24-0024. The purpose of the permit revision is to increase the permitted disposal area within AVPL from 125 acres to 181 acres (in increase of 56 acres). The revision also includes limited waste and recyclable acceptance on Sundays between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., to provide flexibility to Antelope Valley residents via private vehicle, hand deliveries to the AVPL. The permitted facility boundary will increase from 185 acres to 351 acres. The 56-acre increase in disposal area will increase the landfill design capacity from 30.2mcy to 43.9mcy as outlined in the Joint Technical Document.

LEA's Determination

On January 16, 2026, the LEA completed the review of the permit revision application package and determined the application to be complete and correct per Section 21665. The application package meets the requirements of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations (27 CCR) § 21570 (f) and it is accepted for filing. A public hearing was conducted by the City of Palmdale Planning Commission on November 13, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at the City Council Chambers to receive comments and approve the Conditional Use Permit 98-12 Modification No.24-0024 project. The LEA was present at the public hearing and available to answer questions pursuant to 27 CCR § 21660.4. Public notices for the meeting were published in the local paper, posted at the Palmdale library and mailed to property owners within 1,000 feet radius of the property boundary. This Substitute Public Notice will be posted at the LEA's public notice board, Palmdale City Hall and Palmdale Library and at the facility.
