- In times of emergency, family and pets stick together.
 - Don't forget your most prized possessions - evacuate "all creatures great and small."
 - If you a minor, make sure to connect with an adult or parent in charge.
 - Your pet should have identification - a microchip and external tag.
- You have one chance to get out.
 - How many pets can you carry out with you at one time?
 - Pets also need evacuation kits - Extra food, water, medicines, leash, crate
 - Know your pet evacuation options, such as a pet-friendly hotel or friend's house
- Prepare for emergencies: Plan for yourself. Plan for your pets.
 - Create a kit for your pet, including a pet first aid kit.
 - A pet emergency kit should include: extra food, water, medicines, leash, crate.
 - Make sure you have your pet's medical records, including the vaccine history.
