How to Apply Insect Repellent

DO:

- ✓ Always follow label directions and read precautions before applying
- ✓ Wash your hands with soap after, especially before eating and drinking
- ✓ Use only enough repellent to cover exposed skin (and clothes if using spray)
- ✓ If using spray, hold the spray 6-8 inches away and spray slowly and evenly

DON'T:

- X Don't use any near your eyes, nose, mouth, ears, or open cuts
- Don't use on babies younger than 2 months
- X Don't use under clothing
- X Don't use to kill insects
- X Don't reapply more often than directed by the product label
