The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is warning consumers not to eat Shemshad's Mulberry Molasses and Mulberry Jam jarred food products dated "APR 25 2025". They may be contaminated with Botulism.





They are sold at stores including Woodland Hills Market in Woodland Hills and Q Market in Van Nuys.



Botulism is a potentially fatal form of food poisoning.

If you experience the following symptoms, seek immediate medical attention:

- general weakness
- difficulty breathing
- swollen abdomen
- dizziness
- double-vision
- trouble with speaking or swallowing.
