NOTICE: COMPLIANCE TRAINING ON AB 300 - THE SAFE BODY ART ACT

Dear Body Art Practitioner:

On October 9, 2011, Governor Brown signed AB 300, also known as the "Safe Body Art Act." The intent of the law is to provide fair, safe and enforceable standards across California for body art, including tattooing, permanent make-up, body piercing, and branding. The law prohibits a person from performing body art without registering annually with the local enforcement agency; requires practitioners to comply with vaccination, bloodborne pathogen training, and sanitation requirements; and requires the owner of a body art facility to obtain and annually renew a health permit. Body art practitioners have until July 1, 2012 to comply with the requirements of the law.

The California Association of Environmental Health Administrators (CAEHA) in collaboration with practitioners, local health and environmental health officials, and health training specialists will be hosting Compliance Training on the Safe Body Art Act in various cities throughout California. Training will be held on January 19, 2012, from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, at Los Angeles County Environmental Health Headquarters, 5050 Commerce Drive, Baldwin Park, CA 91706. Topics discussed will include an overview of the law, practitioner registration requirements, safe body art practices, enforcement, and mechanical and clasp ear piercing. The training will be followed by a Q&A session.

THE LAW: AB 300 (Ma) The Safe Body Art Act was signed into law on October 9, 2011. This law applies to all body art including piercing, tattoos and permanent cosmetics but there are limited requirements for mechanical ear piercing. It also applies to permanent, temporary and mobile body art facilities. The law becomes effective on January 1, 2012 but the compliance date for registration and facility permitting is July 1, 2012.

THE TRAINING: The training sessions will be facilitated by CAEHA and other sponsors and will begin January 2012. Each training session will consist of a full day of training offered on several locations throughout California. The training sessions are designed to meet training requirements in AB 300 for practitioner registration, instructors from public environmental health and industry. The topics covered during the course are overview of the law, practitioner registration requirements, bloodborne pathogen exposure control training, safe body art practices, permanent body art facility requirements, temporary body art facilities, enforcement, and mechanical stud and clasp ear piercing. The training will be followed by a Q&A session and certificates will be issued at the end of the day.
