Crows and Ravens

Please call the hotline above immediately to pick-up dead birds. In order to test for West Nile Virus, bird carcasses must be fresh (i.e., dead less than 24 hours). **Never** handle a dead bird with bare hands – use gloves, shovel or intact waterproof bag. Place dead bird(s) in a bag and leave in an area that will not be disturbed by other people or animals for pick-up.
