**VISION** *To have and maintain a healthy Los Angeles County community for all people.*

### MISSION

### GUIDING PRINCIPLES

**Educate** health providers to promote timely age-appropriate immunization information.

**Improve** access to care to decrease disparities across the lifespan.

**Foster** creativity and respect for diverse ideas.

### OBJECTIVES

**Diversify** and expand membership in the Immunization Coalition of Los Angeles County.

**Define** and develop the coordination role between other coalitions.

**Strengthen** ICLAC's fiscal viability by seeking out and applying for grant proposals to support new and innovative immunization program initiatives in Los Angeles County.

**Enhance** recognition and visibility of the Immunization Coalition of Los Angeles County.

**Expand** ICLAC's role in advocacy efforts that affect immunizations in Los Angeles County.

**Reduce** disparities in immunization rates in Los Angeles County.

### STRUCTURE

**General Membership:** A public/private partnership of schools, community clinics, vaccine companies, health plans, government agencies, businesses, and community based organizations, and concerned individuals.

**Meetings:** Members meet quarterly to share information on best immunization practices as well as to hear immunization information at the national, state, and local levels. No fee.

**Steering Committee:** Members volunteer their time in an advisory capacity to oversee policy and budget related activities on behalf of the coalition. The Steering Committee meets on an as needed basis at this time.
