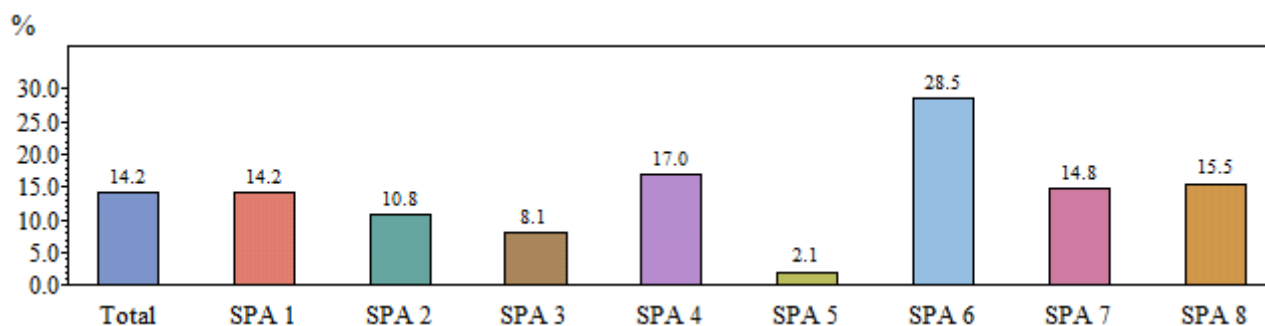


Social Environment: Perceived neighborhood as unsafe
