








SARS-CoV-2 Variants as a Percentage of All Specimens **Sequenced for Baseline Variant Surveillance**



✓ Recommend physical distancing in communal areas such as breakrooms, cafeterias




At worksites with potential outbreaks (3+ cases within 14 days)

14-Day Cumulative Age-Adjusted Hospital Admission Rate by Area Poverty Level March 1, 2022 – June 17, 2022






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14-Day Cumulative Age-Adjusted Hospital Admission Rate by Race/Ethnicity March 1, 2022 – June 17, 2022
