

Number of COVID-19 Cases by Episode Date, Hospitalizations and Deaths by Date of Death March 1, 2020 – October 6, 2021










7-Day Average Case Counts by Vaccination Status* March 1, 2020 – October 2, 2021









7-Day Average Death Counts by Vaccination Status* March 1, 2020 – October 2, 2021








Number of Cases by Age Group, August 29 - October 1, 2021





Crude Case Rate per 100,000 People* by Age Group and Vaccination Status August 29 – October 1, 2021



Number of Hospitalizations by Age Group August 29 – October 1, 2021



Crude Hospitalization Rate per 100,000 People* by Age Group and Vaccination Status, August 29 – October 1, 2021



Number of Deaths by Age Group August 29 – October 1, 2021




Covid Among Fully Vaccinated People in LAC as of October 9th, 2021

Lambda and Mu Variants, Cases by Week of Specimen Collection









New Health Officer Order, September 28th, 2021

Bars, Breweries, Wineries, Distilleries, Nightclubs, and Lounges

- 10/7/21: Proof of ≥1 dose vaccine + photo ID required for indoor entry for all patrons and employees; <12 do not require either
- 11/4/21: Proof of full vaccination + photo ID required for indoor entry for all patrons and employees; <12 do not require either
- Masks still required indoors for everyone
- No negative test alternative
- If no proof of vaccination, indoor entry only when masked and for outdoor/restroom access, ordering/paying at register, or order pickup.



New Health Officer Order, September 28th, 2021

Outdoor Mega Events (>10,000)

- 10/7/21: Proof of full vaccination OR recent negative test required for all patrons 12+
- 11/1/21: Proof of full vaccination OR recent negative test + photo ID required for all patrons 18+
- Masks still required for everyone at all indoor events and outdoor mega events

Watching the Big Games Safely



At a Sports Bar

- Ensure you + any teens have ≥1 dose (before 11/4) or are fully vaccinated (11/4 or after)
- Bring proof of vaccination and photo ID for everyone in your party
- Wear masks except when actively eating or drinking
- Consider using outdoor areas for extra safety



At an Arena

- Ensure you + accompanying teens are fully vaccinated or have recent negative test
- Bring proof of vaccination or negative test result for everyone in your party and photo ID for everyone 18+
- Wear masks except when actively eating or drinking
