



KEY FINDINGS


- Nearly ½ have a disability
- 1/3 report depression
- 91% engage in wellness activities
- 2/3 have been victimized
 3 or more times
- 13% have been denied healthcare or rec'd inferior care
- More than 20% do not disclose SO/GI





- Avg. levels: 68.3 for lesbians; 65.6 for bisexual women
- Rates of poor health: 23% of lesbians; 22% bisexual women;
 33% of transgender people
- Ltd. P.A. & Special Eqpt: 53% lesbians, 51% bisexual women; 62% transgender people
- **Obesity:** 34% of L; 34% of bi; 40% of trans (19% of gay men)

lesbians; 35% for bisexual women;


Loneliness/Social Isolation: 59%

Accessing Care



- More than 20% of LGBT older adults do not disclose their sexual orientation or gender identity to physicians or care providers.
- 13% have been denied healthcare or received inferior care.







Exercise: 84% of Ls, 69% of Bs engage in moderate activities weekly; 51% LGBT in vigorous activities; 91% in wellness (e.g. meditation, photogr.)


Sexual Activity: 55% of LGBT have been sexually active within 12 mos

Health Screening: 84% of women had a mammogram; 66% had a Pap smear

Smoking: 7% of lesbians; 15% of bi women and 15% of trans o.a. currently smoke

Excessive Drinking: 8% of lesbians, 8% of bisexual; 20% of trans o.a.

HIV risk behaviors: 4% of lesbians; 14% of bi women; 20% of trans (26% of gay men)



<u>Resilience</u>

- 89% feel positive about being in LGBT community
- 2/3 have someone to help with chores when sick (1/3 do not)
- 38% participate in religious or spiritual activity monthly

<u>Risk</u>

- 82% victimized at least once
- 64%, 3 x or more
- Verbal (68%); threat of violence (43%); hassle by police (27%)
- 20% physically assaulted
- More than ½, discriminated in employment or housing
