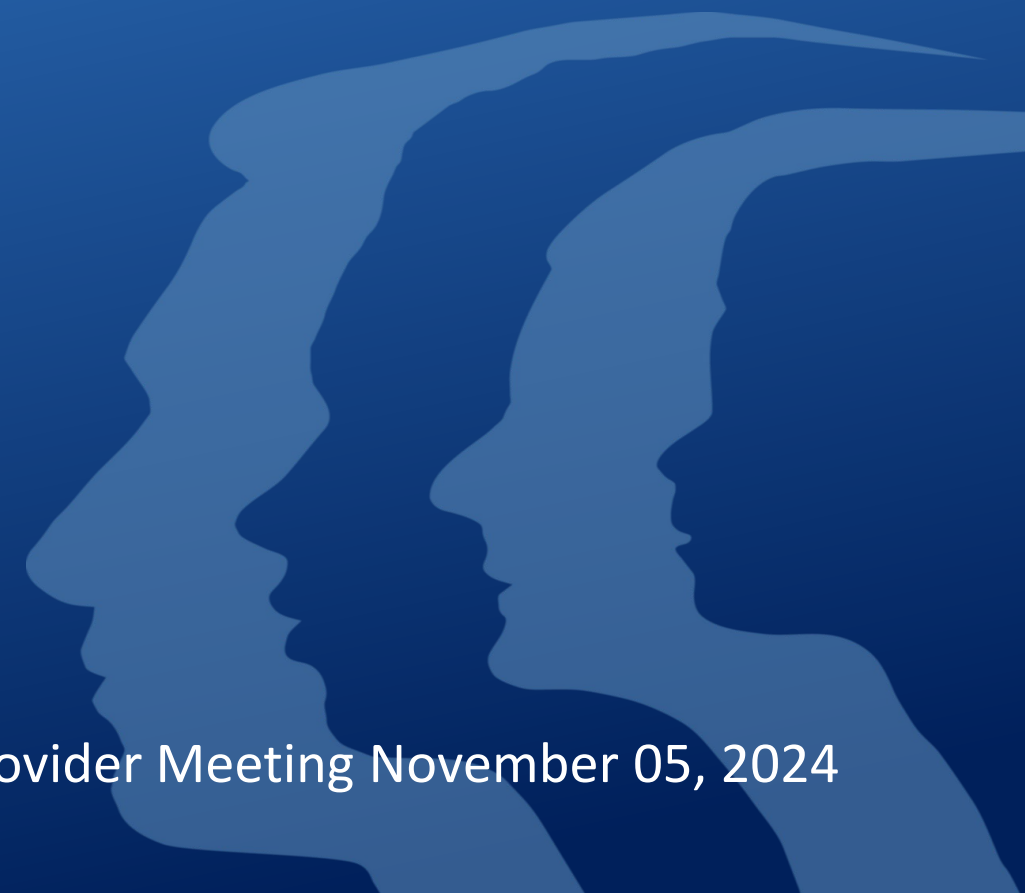

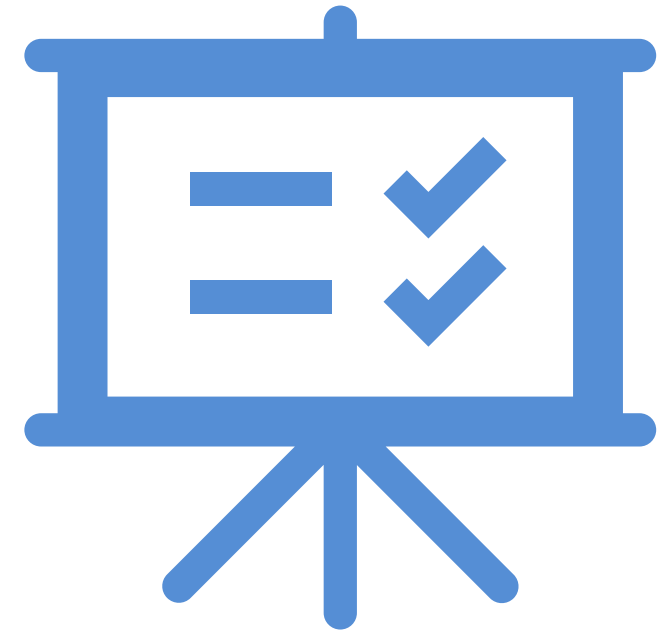

# Sage Updates



- Real Time Eligibility (270) Request DOB, Aid code and County Code fields are now visible and correct.
- Viewing and downloading historical attachments from ProviderConnect File Attach

Items that have been resolved:



- Documents in Draft and for Co Signature Drug Test section
- Provider File Attach widget visibility
- Progress Note Status Report performance issues
- CalOMS Discharge Error (week of 11/04)

# Document Routing and Printing Policies



## To Route or Not to Route

- Document Routing is optional.
- Providers can continue to use the Draft and Ready to Submit check box if unable to implement routing.
- Appending is available for provider use whether or not the document was routed.

## To Print or Not to Print

- **SAPC does not require printing of any clinical document unless explicitly requested to do so for audit or UM needs. There is no SAPC policy that mandates printing of clinical documents.**
- **DHCS auditors should not need the chart to be printed during a state audit.**
  - **Auditors can be granted access to Sage under the Audit user role.**
- **DHCS nor UM require wet signatures on Problem List/Treatment plans since CalAIM document reform implementation as of 7/1/2023.**

## Report or Widget

- **Documents in Draft and for Co Signature report is a worklist to identify Progress Notes, Patient Medication, Drug Tests, Discharge and Transfer forms and RBH Discharge forms in draft, routed for approval or rejected statuses.**
- **Widgets on the Documents in Draft and for Co\_Signature view is a worklist to identify any of the 9 forms that are document routed in able in draft, routed for approval or rejected status for documents dated within a rolling month/4-week period.**
- **\*\*\*Currently the Drug Test portion of the report is not functioning correctly and providers should only use the widget for Drug Tests status until further notice**
