

DO YOU SELL TOBACCO?

Effective April 16, 2008, the sale of tobacco, tobacco products, and tobacco paraphernalia without a valid Los Angeles County Tobacco Retail License in the unincorporated areas of the County is prohibited by law. This license is required in addition to a California State Board of Equalization Tobacco Retailer's License.

YOU NEED BOTH LICENSES

Pursuant to Chapter 11.35 of the Los Angeles County Code, violators are subject to prosecution, fines up to \$1,000 and other penalties, including forfeiting the right to sell and display tobacco, tobacco products, and tobacco paraphernalia, and having a lien assessed on your business.

Tobacco retailers that are not in the unincorporated areas of the County do not need the LA County Tobacco Retail License. If your business is in a specific city in the County, check to see if that city has its own tobacco retail license/permit requirements.
