## Animal Health Alert: Confirmation of COVID-19 in Two Pet Cats in New York 4.23.2020

Dear Colleagues,

Today, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National Veterinary Services Laboratories announced the first confirmed cases of SARS-CoV-2 infection in two pet cats in the United States. The cats live in two separate areas of New York state. Both cats had symptoms of mild respiratory illness. More details are available in the <u>press release</u>.

We want to emphasize that there is still no evidence that pets play a role in spreading the virus in the United States. At this time, routine testing of animals for SARS-CoV-2 is not recommended and there is no justification in taking measures against animals or pets that may compromise their welfare. As always, we are learning more about COVID-19 each day and further studies will help us better understand how pets and other animals may be affected.
