Rabies is a virus that is spread through saliva when an infected animal bites a human.



Never touch a bat with your bare hands. Call animal control if you find a bat in your home. Seek medical care if bitten by or exposed to a bat.



Rabies is preventable. Vaccinate your pets, including indoor only cats and dogs. Keep your pets away from wildlife.
